



Spicer Lake Nature Preserve

In 1978, with the assistance of the South Bend Audubon Society, the Indiana Chapter of The Nature Conservancy and the IDNR, the Board acquired 40 acres, known as Spicer Lake, in the extreme northwest corner of the county on County Line Road, in New Carlisle. It was dedicated as a State Nature Preserve. The Board now owns 320 acres surrounding Spicer and Lancaster Lakes, featuring over 7 miles of trails along wetlands, woods and old-growth fields. A boardwalk and observation platforms enhance nature observation.
