

Fishing Tips

If you plan on fishing during your canoe trip, remember that a current fishing license is required to fish in Indiana *and* Michigan. Your canoe trip will take you through both states if your end point is the Niles Dam public landing.

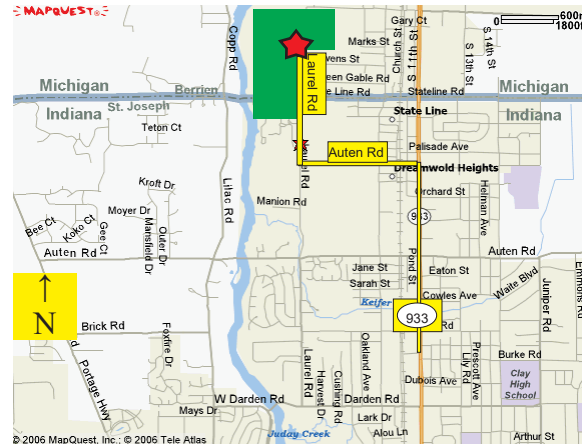


Below are guidelines of when different species of fish may be found. Weather and conditions will affect spawning and availability of fish. Bluegill, carp, catfish, sucker, sunfish and others may be caught year 'round.

New Saturday October Fall Paddle dates - TBA

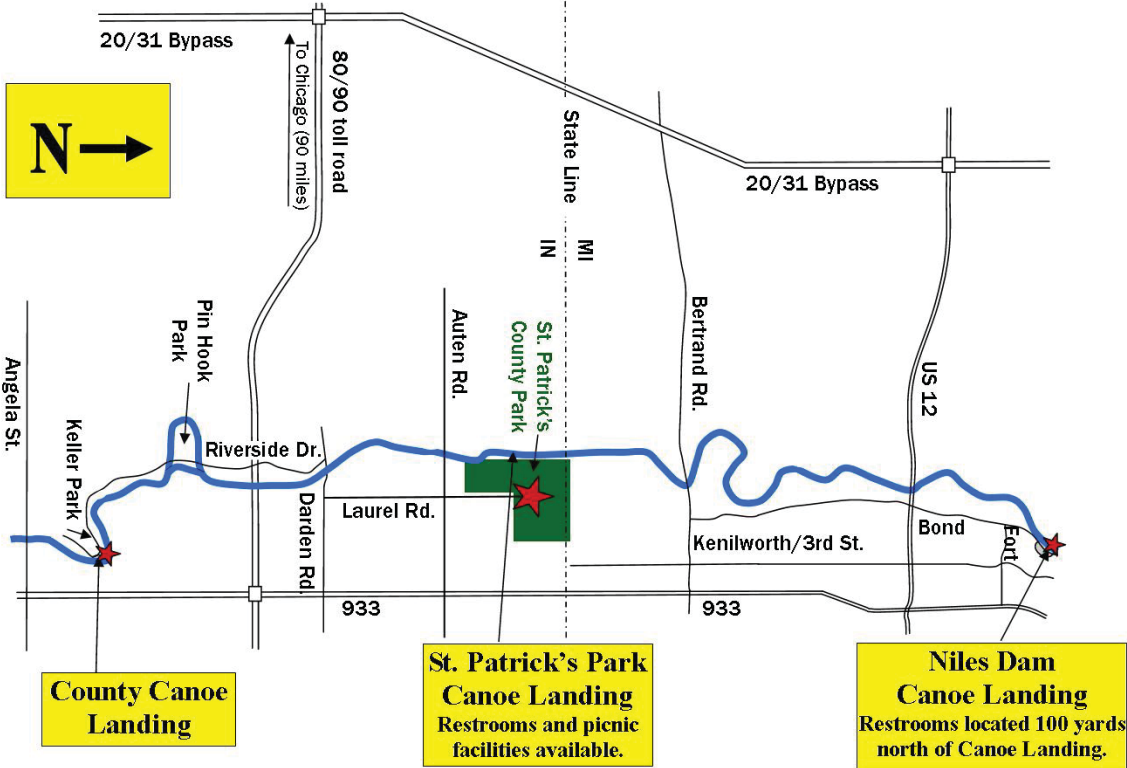
Time: 11am-4pm (equipment returned by 7pm)
 Long trips weekends only, rental ends at 2pm
 Friday shuttles depart on the hour

Fee: Different depending on long or short trip, and vessel rental. Kayak & SUP supply is limited.

We also offer a beginner's practice pond, livery of private equipment, and group canoe reservations for 5-30 canoes.

Call the St. Joseph County Parks at 574/277-4828 prior to your visit for SUP & kayak availability and to discuss all trip options and prices.

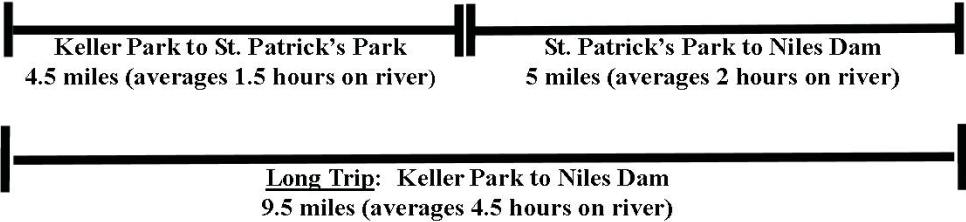
Evening Paddle

Niles Dam Canoe Landing
 Restrooms located 100 yards north of Canoe Landing.



Rental packages include: vessel, paddles, required life jackets (and shuttle service at St. Patrick's County Park). Parental signatures required for renters under age 18.

Bring plenty of water. Consider bringing sunscreen, insect repellent, water shoes, and a picnic or snack.

Rental closes if weather or river conditions are unsafe.
