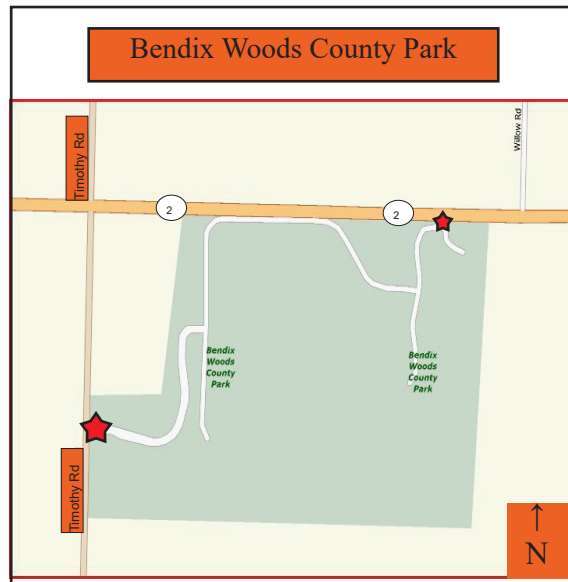

Evening Hayrides

When: Wednesdays-Sundays
late Sept. through early Nov.

Timeslots: 1-3pm; 3:30-5:30pm; 6-8pm;
8:30-10:30pm

Fee: \$120 for up to 80 people for 2 hours

Tractor drawn evening hayrides include a campfire. Restrooms are near the campfire site. A picnic shelter or building is NOT included. However, on a limited basis, and with an additional fee, you can rent a nearby picnic shelter.

To Make A Reservation

Please call park staff at 574/654-3155 and schedule an available date and time.

Once your date and time has been confirmed, log onto sjcparks.org to print off a hayride reservation packet.

Completed agreement along with payment must be received to guarantee your reservation.



A Few Rules...

Groups are welcome to bring snacks, however, if your group has a campfire and you plan to roast hot dogs or marshmallows, you must bring your own roasting sticks.

Collecting sticks is not allowed on park property. No food or beverages are allowed on the hay wagons. No smoking is allowed in the park. No more than 20 people per wagon load. The tractor driver, park ranger and other park staff enforce these rules for your safety.

Morning Hayrides

When: Wednesdays-Fridays
late Sept. through Oct.

Timeslots: 9-11am; 9:30-11:30am;
10am-noon

Fee: \$75 for up to 80 people for 2 hours

A great idea for school groups and company outings! No campfire, but everything else is the same as the evening hayride options. Adult groups may request a campfire for an additional \$35 at the time of reservation.



Cancellations & Refunds

Cancellations due to weather are at the discretion of the St. Joseph County Park staff. Our programs are offered outdoors year-round, and we will generally only cancel if weather is severe. If the weather is severe, we will phone you two hours prior to your hayride to attempt to reschedule. If it is not possible to reschedule the hayride, a complete refund will be issued. If your group cancels following payment and up to two weeks prior to the hayride date, 20% of the total fee will be withheld. For cancellations made within two weeks of the hayride date, no refunds will be issued.
